

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Kelli Hansen presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were: Alan Dinkel, Shelly Haas, Daryl Sherraden, and Deb Meyers. Quentin Meyers was absent.

All present stood for the flag salute.

Sherraden moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from October 3, 2017. Haas seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Dinkel moved to pay bills in the amount of \$440,447.37. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Mayor Kelli Hansen Reported:

- The annual Fall Festival will be October 29<sup>th</sup>.
- There will be another Strategic Doing meeting on November 15<sup>th</sup>.

Public Works Supervisor Jerry Hageman reported:

- The Rescue Squad would like some milling for their driveway area.
  - ◆ Sherraden moved to allow the Rescue Squad to have the number of millings needed to complete their driveway area. Dinkel seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- Approximately 40 city blocks of streets have been sealed.
  - ◆ Dinkel moved to allow Don's Electric to make the needed repairs to the sewer pump for \$4,900.00. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

City Attorney Jerry Smetana reported:


- Two ordinances need to pass to accept the 2017 Uniform Public Offense Code and the Standard Traffic Ordinance.
  - ◆ Sherraden moved to accept Ordinance G-17-05 adopting the 2017 Standard Traffic Ordinance. Dinkel seconded the motion. The motion passed.
  - ◆ Dinkel moved to accept Ordinance G-17-06 adopting the 2017 Uniform Public Offense Code. Haas seconded the motion. The motion passed.

City Administrator/Clerk Jim Mesecher reported:

- Lynn Williams representing Fred Hambright, Incorporated presented a proposal for an Oil and Gas Lease for certain City owned property.
  - ◆ Sherraden moved to allow the Mayor and Clerk to sign the lease. Haas seconded the motion. The motion passed.

- Two drafted development agreements between the Greater Salina Community Foundation and the City of Plainville, and between the City of Plainville and Joiner Construction, Inc. were given to City Attorney Jerry Smetana for review.

Dinkel moved to adjourn the meeting. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 7:39 PM.
