

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Council President Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were: Alan Dinkel, Shelly Haas, and Deb Meyers. Mayor Kelli Hansen and Daryl Sherraden were absent.

All present stood for the flag salute.

Dinkel moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from September 19, 2017. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Dinkel moved to pay bills in the amount of \$72,556.93. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Public Works Supervisor Jerry Hageman reported:

- Water Well #20 needs maintenance. The cost given by Clark Well and Equipment was \$7,800.00.
 - ◆ Haas moved to allow Clark Well and Equipment to perform the needed maintenance for \$7,800.00. Dinkel seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- One of the sewer pumps is out of service and needs repaired. Don's Electric can fix the pump for a cost of \$4,900.00.
 - ◆ Dinkel moved to allow Don's Electric to make the needed repairs to the sewer pump for \$4,900.00. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- Oil for sealing the streets needs to be purchased. It can be purchased from the County and the cost should not exceed \$25,000.00.
 - ◆ Dinkel moved to allow the purchase of oil from the County for the sealing of streets with a cost not to exceed \$25,000.00. Haas seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Council President Quentin Meyers informed the Council that one of the fire trucks and the fire house received minor accident damage. A claim has been submitted to the City's insurance agency.

Dinkel moved to adjourn the meeting. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed. The meeting was adjourned at 7:23 PM.
