

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were: Shelly Haas, Deb Meyers, Daryl Sherraden, Ryan Weltmer, and James Balthazor.

All present stood for the flag salute.

Sherraden moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from February 6, 2018. Haas seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Deb Meyers moved to pay bills in the amount of \$131,249.45. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Brett Greenwood presented a statement outlining his views as to how he felt the City Council's meeting agenda may be put to better use. The Council thanked him for his input. Mayor Quentin Meyers gave a rebuttal statement addressing each of Mr. Greenwood's views that he had shared at the February 6th regular meeting.

Police Chief Troy Rudman reported:

- The City of Plainville is hosting police officer training with approximately 40-50 officers from today through the 22nd.
- Chief Rudman and Captain Davis will be attending the KNOA training from March 5th through March 8th.

Public Works Supervisor Jerry Hageman reported:

- Some small water leaks have been repaired.
- Is looking into better ways to monitor the burn pit so State regulations are always met.
- An invoice for repairs made to a street department vehicle needs approval.
 - ◆ Sherraden moved to approve payment of the invoice from Bosselman Energy in the amount of \$1,745.00. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

City Administrator/Clerk Jim Mesecher reported:

- Will begin working on the 2019 Budget.

Councilmember Haas reported:

- Would like to call an executive session to discuss matters of non-elected personnel.
 - ◆ Sherraden moved to recess into executive session with the Governing Body, to discuss matters relating to non-elected personnel, to protect the privacy of those involved, and to return to open meeting in the Council Chamber at 7:46 pm. Haas seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- The Governing Body returned to the table at 7:46 PM with no action taken.


