

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were: Shelly Haas, Deb Meyers, Daryl Sherraden, Ryan Weltmer, and James Balthazor.

All present stood for the flag salute.

Haas moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from March 6, 2018. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Balthazor moved to pay bills in the amount of \$62,357.04. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Paul Gross with Plainville Insurance Agency presented the proposed 2018-2019 EMC insurance premium.

- Sherraden moved to accept the proposal as presented in the amount of \$76,638.00. Weltmer seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Municipal Judge Doug Bigge and Attorney Danielle Muir addressed the Council as to the policies and procedures of Plainville's Municipal Court and possible areas which could they felt may be improved.

- Sherraden moved to recess into executive session with the Governing Body and Muir, to discuss matters relating to the hiring of non-elected personnel, to protect the privacy of those involved, and to return to open meeting in the Council Chamber at 8:40 PM. Haas seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- The Governing Body and Muir returned to the table at 8:40 PM. No action taken.

- Sherraden moved to allow Chris Davis's residence to be hooked to the City's sewer system. Balthazor seconded the motion. The motion passed.
