

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were: Shelly Haas, Deb Meyers, Daryl Sherraden, Ryan Weltmer, and James Balthazor.

- Would like to see something done to clean up several empty dirt lots throughout the City. Will have the City's Compliance Officer check into the issue.

Councilmember Balthazor reported:
