

The City Council of the City of Plainville met in regular session at the City Hall with Mayor Quentin Meyers presiding. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM. Council Members present were: Shelly Haas, Deb Meyers, Daryl Sherraden, Ryan Weltmer, and James Balthazor.

All present stood for the flag salute.

Balthazor moved to approve the Regular Council Minutes from August 7, 2018. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Balthazor moved to pay bills in the amount of \$155,895.14. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Tom Carpenter with Mapes & Miller LLP presented and reviewed the 2017 Audit with a clean opinion by the firm.

- Haas moved to accept the 2017 Audit as presented by Mapes & Miller LLP. Weltmer seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Jay Brock with Ravason LLC was in attendance for a requested hearing involving the Notice of Violation letters and a bill that was received for the mowing of properties. After discussion,

- Balthazor moved to extend the due date of the amount due by 14 days. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.
- Balthazor moved to extend the due date of the Notice of Violation letters dated August 14, 2018 by 14 days. Weltmer seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Kacy Becker asked if there may be a solution to a sewer line issue at her residence. Public Works Supervisor Jerry Hageman will check into possible monitoring options.

Public Works Supervisor Jerry Hageman reported:

- Will check on the possibility of additional shaded areas at the pool.
- An invoice for \$1,248.45 from Core and Main for a sewer check valve needs approval.
  - ◆ Sherraden moved to approve the invoice from Core and Main for \$1,248.45. Deb Meyers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Chief of Police Troy Rudman reported:

- Vehicle 101 needs some repairs made to the steering system.
  - ◆ Balthazor moved to allow Kustom Auto to make the needed repairs not to exceed \$1,500.00. Sherraden seconded the motion. The motion passed.

City Administrator/Clerk Jim Mesecher reported:

- Discussed possible changes to chapter 2 of the City's code book.
- An invoice from Hays Fire and Rescue for truck repairs needs approval.

- ◆ Balthazor moved to approve the invoice from Hays Fire and Rescue in the amount of \$2,314.50. Haas seconded the motion. The motion passed.

City Attorney Michael Baxter reported:

- The City's code does not apply to a measured radius outside the City's limits.
