ORDINANCE NO. G-18-04

**AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING FOR THE RECOVERY OF
COSTS NECESSARY FOR THE COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT DEBTS**


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PLAINVILLE, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: The governing body of the City of Plainville is authorized to enter into contracts or agreements necessary for the collection of delinquent debts owed to the City of Plainville.

SECTION 2: Any person or entity delinquent on any charges, fees, costs, assessments, and/or fines owed to the City of Plainville shall pay any and all charges related to the reasonable costs of collection of said charges, fees, costs, assessments, or fines. This shall apply to, but is not limited to, charges for water, trash, electricity, code violations, parking tickets, municipal court fines, fees, court costs, interest accrued thereon, or any other debt due and owing to the City of Plainville. The costs of collection shall include, but are not limited to, court costs, surcharges, attorney fees, and collection agency fees, except that such costs of collection may not include both attorney fees and collection agency fees.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
